AP Warrants 11320 – 11408 totaling \$63,728.44 were approved. AP ACH totaling \$2,576.59 were approved. Payroll Warrants 807719 – 807732 totaling \$12,350.45 were approved. PR DD/EFT/ACH totaling \$114,577.02 were approved.

Board reviewed 3rd Quarter financials.

Chiefs Report

- Wildland Fires so far 2015:
 - ➤ 18 Mobilizations or fires in which District 10 able to bill for equipment assistance at 3715 hours.
 - ➤ Out of 500 wildland fires in Spokane County, 14% were in District 10. This was increase over 2014's 8%.
 - ➤ 400 acres burned in District 10 in 2015, 2.9 acres in 2014 and 95 acres 2011-2014.
 - > 2015 causes ranged from human caused intentional or unintentional, to equipment failure, to unknown.
- Significant local and regional show of firefighter support this year.

- Fire Danger still at high with outdoor burn restrictions still in place in Spokane
 County. DNR needs to get loggers in the woods before the snow flies.
- Recruit school training tower overheat issue, investigation ongoing. Helmet shields and ppe inspected. All SCBA masks inspected (Scott Masks rated 400 degree - 5 min duration over life of face piece). (Not simply exposure to heat though)
- New Scott SCBA Mask fit problem issue New vs Old version
- Looking into fit testing equipment to purchase so we can do anytime needed, not be dependent on other agencies. Cost estimated at \$9-10K.
- New AEDS in service. All front line Engines, Brush, Rescue, Attack and Support unit outfitted and we have one spare.
- Commissioner conference Oct 21-23 Tulalip WA. Chief Scharff is planning on attending.
- Lt Anderson attended a demonstration of the county's GIS mapping software

Old Business

 CSA Update – Nothing new to report. Chief Scharff will meet with Chief Metzger.
 The city of Airway Heights is planning on putting an EMS Levy on the November ballot.

New Business

- 1. Preliminary Budget AD Callahan presented a preliminary budget for board review.
- 2. Deputy Chief Resignation Deputy Chief Ladd has submitted his resignation. His last day will be October 30, 2015.
