310.09 Support Services Program

- I. Support Services Volunteers will perform duties in support of operational activities at incidents, such as rehab or logistical support. These members may also participate in indirect firefighting activities such as operating water tenders. Support Services members may also assist in non-emergency functions such as administrative support, public education, and other areas.
- II. Support Services candidates will complete an entry process similar to volunteer firefighters, but commensurate with their duties. These candidates will complete an initial training course, and also must be trained and certified in the various duties expected.
- III. Support Services members do not need to reside within the District, but must meet minimum training and activity levels to maintain membership.
- IV. Support Services members will be eligible for the same reimbursement as firefighters for tasks and training they participate in as per the District Points system (Section 500).
- V. Subject to the Board of Volunteer Firefighter and Reserve Officers rules and regulations, Support Services members may participate in the State Volunteer Firefighter's pension system.
